**Q.NO.1 Comment on any 8 of the following:**

- a) A Government servant in the pay scale of 5800-200-7000-220-8100-275-9200 is Promoted to a post carrying pay scale of Rs. 5800-200-8100-275-9200. His pay on promotion is fixed at the same stage of pay (Rs.8925) at which he was drawing his pay before promotion. His DNI also remains unchanged. The government Servant objects to the fixation.
- b) A Government servant on 76 days Extra ordinary leave is paid neither any leave salary nor any compensatory allowances for this period.
- c) A Government servant was transferred to station 'B' from Station 'A' . The Distance between both the offices is 19 kms. He claims transfer grant but the Treasury Officer objects to the same.
- d) A Government servant is served with a show cause notice and without holding detailed inquiry is inflicted penalty of stoppage of next increment for 3 years with Cumulative effect. The Government servant represents that the penalty cannot be Inflicted without conducting detailed inquiry.
- e) A Government servant in the month of April, 2006 increases his subscription to GPF to Rs.5000, in September to Rs. 6000 and then decreases it to Rs.5000 again In December 2006. The DDO rejects the application for decrease on the plea that Frequent changes cannot be effected in the subscription.
- f) A Government nominates his minor mother as his nominee for GPF Accumulations Although he was married and did have one son beside his own wife. The nomination is accepted by the Accounts Officer.
- g) A government servant whose family did not accompany him on transfer did not claim his own T.A. When his family accompanied him to the station of transfer

Within 3 months, he prefers his own T.A. claim for the second journey. Originally he had traveled by ordinary class of public transport and subsequently he had traveled in Delux class of transport alongwith his family. The Controlling Officer asserts that he is entitled to claim only the traveling allowance pertaining to his first journey.

- h) A Government servants quits service on 10th of January 2006 and claim his pay IST to 10<sup>th</sup> January 2006 on 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2006. The DDO does not agree on the plea That pay for January, 2006 becomes payable on Ist of February, 2006 and hence Cannot be drawn before that date.
- i) A Class-III government servant retires on superannuation while under suspension. The inquiry is concluded after this date and his Disciplinary Authority (hen he was in Service) inflicts penalty of reduction in pension. The government servant objects and Challenges that the authority that issued this order was not competent to make such Order after his retirement.
- j) A government enters in a drunken state in his office and disturbs office functioning. When he was got medically examined, the Medical officers certificates that although He had taken alcohol yet was not in its influence. The inquiry is conducted and Concluded and he is inflicted a major penalty of compulsory retirement. (5 x 8)

Q.No.II.a) when does a Travelling allowance claim become time barred.

- b) Calculate traveling allowance admissible to a government servant with his Headquarters at Dharamshala, for the below mentioned journeys:

Leaves Dharamshala on 1-11-2006 at 9.00 hours and reaches Jasoor at 1300hrs.  
Leaves jasoor on 3-11-2006 at 1000 hrs. and reaches chamba at 1600 hours.  
Leaves Chamba on 6-11-06 at 1100 hours and reaches Bharmour at 1800 hrs.  
Leaves Bharmour on 8-11-06 at 0900 hrs. and reaches Dharamshala 2300hrs.

All the journeys were performed in government vehicle. It is also certified that The government servant has performed official duty at all the stations of halt. Presume that the distance between any of the above two stations was not than 100 kms

The officer is a Grade –II Government servant. (5+ 15)
