The available number of vacancies at present is 3 (three) at Shimla.

The remuneration for the posts is Rs. 12000/- P.M. (all inclusive). Applicants should be between 21-60 years as on 1.7.2007. The appointments are purely temporary and are not likely to be regularized even in future. The initial contract period will be for 1 year but can be extended for one year at a time subsequently subject to the need for the post and satisfactory work of the candidate selected.

Those short-listed for the posts will be required to appear for written test/interview before the Selection Committee at Shimla. No TA/DA will be paid for appearing in the Interview.

The essential qualification for the posts is a Post Graduate in Public Administration/Economics/Social Work/Agriculture/Rural Development. Those with a degree in Law/Management can also apply. Proficiency in use of computers is essential. Educational qualification can be relaxed for retired officers with experiences in the area of Rural Development.

## **Vacancy Details**

Two posts of faculty are required in the State Institute of Rural Development (SIRD). The job will require training government employees from the RD & PR Department, elected representatives of PRI's and officials from other departments/ institutions concerned with rural development and undertake Case/ Research/ Evaluation studies and projects in the area of Rural Development. While the main focus will be on NREGA, Social Audit & the Right to Information, those selected will have to acquaint themselves with all aspects of Rural Development viz. various programmes / schemes of the governments (Central & State), issues of transparency & accountability in government and other governance related issues.

One post of faculty is exclusively in the area of Right to Information. The job requirements will include training and capacity building of officials/ non officials including elected representatives of PRIs & ULBs on issues relating to access to information, Research & Documentation, Dissemination of Information and Consultations mainly in the area of Right to Information and related issues.

The Institute may send those selected to undergo training programmes / studies at places other than Shimla for long/ short duration. All expenses in this connection on travel will be met by the Institute while daily allowance as prescribed may be paid to take care of other related expenses. The selected persons should be ready and willing to undertake such tours within / outside the state of Himachal Pradesh as may be required.
